



## BODY AND PAINT WORKER

**THE JOB:** Omnitrans is seeking an individual with excellent body and paint skills to fill a current vacancy in our Maintenance Department. This individual will be under general direction, estimates damages, repairs and paints body or chassis damage on motor coaches, automobiles, and associated equipment. This position will perform, but not limited to, the following duties (the omission of specific statements of duties does not exclude them from the classification if the work is similar, related, or a logical assignment for this classification):

- Checks vehicles or related equipment for damages and estimates repair costs.
- Prepares vehicle surfaces for paint application by removing parts, masking areas and sanding.
- Paints vehicle surfaces through spray application or other means with a variety of paints and related materials.
- Repairs dents and scratches through the application of body repair materials, and/or the replacement of body panels and parts.
- Repairs chassis and related damages through the use of gas, arc welding, MIG, TIG, and plasma equipment.
- Keeps painting equipment, work area and materials in clean and working order; inventories materials and recommends purchase of needed paint, materials, tools and related equipment.
- Provides work direction to Paint and Body Helper.
- Maintains record of work performed, parts used and time worked.
- Provides vacation and temporary relief as required.
- Replaces broken glass windshields & windows as necessary.
- Fabricates parts and tools as necessary.

**THE QUALIFICATIONS:** The successful candidates will possess three (3) years of experience in the painting and body repair or motor coaches, automobiles or related equipment. The ideal Candidate will possess working knowledge of advanced techniques and methods of surface preparation and paint application related to vehicle body work; materials, tools and equipment used in the preparation and repair of body and chassis damaged vehicles and related equipment; safe working practices relating to all assigned job duties. This Individual will also have the ability to determine damages and estimate repair costs; repair body or chassis damages and prepare and paint vehicle surfaces; operate all equipment used in the repair and painting of vehicles; read and understand policies, procedures Agency regulations, and manuals. **A Class C California License is required; a Class B California License with passenger endorsements and air brakes is highly recommended.** The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions for this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions. While performing the duties of this job, the employee is frequently required to talk or hear, use hands to finger, handle or feel, stoop, kneel, crouch or crawl, and reach with hands and arms. The employee is regularly required to stand, walk, and sit. The employee is occasionally required to climb or balance.

**THE SELECTION PROCESS:** Candidates will be screened for relevant qualifying experience that consists of an evaluation of education and experience as described on the application. A CURRENT (30 days or less) California (H6) D.M.V. printout **MUST be submitted with the application.** The most competitively qualified candidates will be invited to participate in the selection process. The selection process may include a combination of written, performance, and oral examinations. All employment offers are contingent upon successful completion of both a pre-employment physical exam, including a drug test, and a criminal background investigation, which could involve Life Scan fingerprinting. (A felony or misdemeanor conviction may disqualify the applicant from employment).
