Omnitrans to Open “Bike Hubitat” at San Bernardino Transit Center *Low-Cost Workshop Benefits Customers, Community Members*

WHO: Omnitrans, the public transit agency serving the San Bernardino Valley.

WHAT: Omnitrans and its partners are introducing the “Bike Hubitat,” a low-cost, do-it-yourself workshop where community members can learn to maintain and repair their own bicycles under the guidance of IEBA staff, utilizing the group’s donated tools.
