

Rogers Named Omnitrans CEO/General Manager

(San Bernardino, CA) Omnitrans' Board of Directors has named transit veteran Erin Rogers the agency's sixth CEO/General Manager. Rogers has served in an interim capacity since last November, and first joined the agency in 2017 as Deputy General Manager. She has nearly three decades of experience in the transit industry, including 16 years at the Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA). Rogers held the position of Assistant General Manager at OCTA for 10 years and was responsible for oversight and management of all fixed route bus and paratransit operations.

Rogers is a native of Syracuse, New York. She graduated from State University of New York, Geneseo with Bachelor of Arts degree in communications, and started her career with DAVE Transportation Services, Inc. in Boston, MA, as a paratransit manager.
