

Omnitrans Announces:

Free Bus Ride Opportunity for Earth Week

(SAN BERNARDINO, CA) — In honor of Earth Day, Omnitrans is providing an incentive to try Earth-friendly transportation with a free one-day mobile bus pass available the week of April 22-26, 2019.

“Switching to transit helps reduce pollution by getting cars off the road,” said Omnitrans spokesperson Wendy Williams, “and the air quality benefit is magnified since we use clean fuel vehicles.”



Omnitrans buses run on clean natural gas.

Omnitrans’ fleet of 178 transit buses are powered by natural gas which generate 88% less particulate matter per passenger mile than traditionally-fueled diesel buses. Using Omnitrans for just one day instead of driving cuts carbon emissions by 20 pounds. Over a year, that translates to nearly 5,000 pounds of emissions.

The free ride offer will be available through the Token Transit mobile app and is limited to one per person. The free pass will be available at: www.tokentransit.com/omniearthweek2019 beginning on April 22. The regular price for a one-day pass is \$5.00.

The Earth Week free ride offer applies to any of Omnitrans 35 bus routes including freeway express and local bus routes, the sbX rapid line, and OmniGo community shuttles; it is not applicable to Access service for persons with disabilities.
