Save money and enjoy unlimited rides with Omnitrans' new fare capping program.

Each time you ride Omnitrans and pay via mobile fare, it will count towards a pass. For example, if you pay \$2 per ride you will receive a Day Pass once you've spent \$6 in one day. Each time you pay, your money will go towards the next level of pass, all the way up to a 31-Day Pass (a \$60 value if you purchase full fare). Once you have paid the value of a 31-Day pass, you can enjoy unlimited rides for the rest of the month. Available only through mobile payment with the Transit or Token Transit apps.

OmniRide is a microtransit service, which is a reservation-based, on-demand shared transit service. OmniRide is operated by Omnitrans, and serves Bloomington, Chino, Chino Hills and Upland areas.

OmniRide Fares

Full fare: \$4 per trip.
Disabled/senior/Medicare/veterans \$1; students \$2
Fares include an Omnitrans 1-day pass for unlimited use and transfers to all Omnitrans services with the exception of OmniAccess.

SINGLE RIDE PASS: Good for a one way trip.

31-DAY PASS: If you're a regular rider, this is the best value! 31-day passes are sold onboard.
