

August Service Changes

As you know, restoring service has been Omnitrans' #1 goal. We're happy to report that all of our routes have been fully restored to their pre-pandemic service levels. Now our focus is on improving routes to make them operate as efficiently as possible to serve you, our customer, better. What does that look like? Running times have been adjusted to make easier connections to other routes and to Metrolink services and to help keep routes running on time. Also, the expansion of **ONTConnect**, aka **Route 380**, (see below for more details).



Route 300 SBConnect will be eliminated. **Routes sbX, 2, 3, 4, 6, 8 and 15** can provide service from the San Bernardino Transit Center to downtown San Bernardino.

Weekday Changes
Routes 1, 2, 15, 19, 81, 82, 84, and 87 will have minor schedule adjustments.

Saturday Changes
Routes 1, 2, 6, 8, 14, 15, 19, 81, and 87 will have minor time adjustments.

Sunday Changes
Routes 2, 3, 4, 6, 8, 15, and 19 will have minor time adjustments.

ONTConnect buses operate **4 AM - 11 PM, Monday - Friday; 6 AM - 11 PM Saturday and Sunday.**

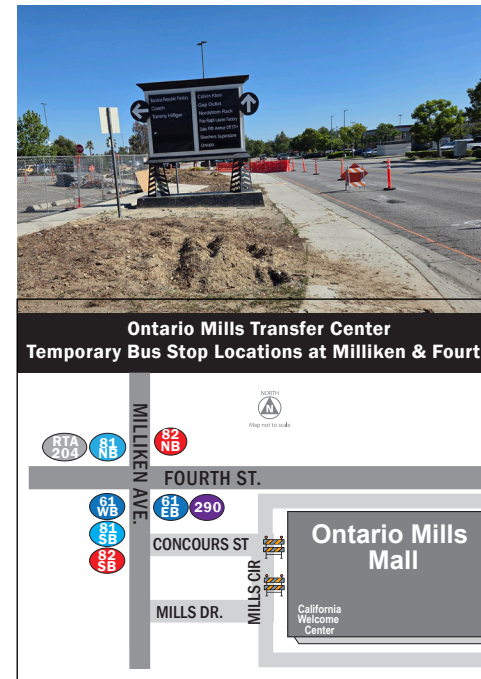

Ontario Mills Transfer Center Is Being Transformed!

Construction along the **West Valley Connector, Omnitrans' next Bus Rapid Transit Line, the sbX Purple Line.** has reached a significant milestone at the **Ontario Mills Transfer Center.** The west end of the **Ontario Mills Mall**, where the **Transfer Center** is located, is under construction to make way for the different sized buses and shelters that will be a part of the **sbX Purple Line.**

Stops for **Routes 61, 81, 82, 290 and RTA204**, located on the west side of the mall, will be closed for a few months. Temporary bus stops have been set up along Milliken Ave. and Fourth Street (see diagram at left). Please note that all other stops around Ontario Mills will remain open.

The good news is that the **Ontario Mills Transfer Center** will re-open in October, just in time for holiday season shopping! Thank you for your patience during this important phase of construction.

If you attend one of our **GoSmart** partner colleges, you can also ride for free. **GoSmart** schools include: **California State University San Bernardino campus, Chaffey College Chino, Fontana and Rancho Cucamonga campuses, Crafton Hills College and San Bernardino Valley College.** (Your current school ID must be scanned in the farebox when boarding.)
