



## Omnitrans, San Bernardino Police Department, and City Partner to Enhance Safety for the Community

**Friday, January 30, 2026** – Last week, Omnitrans, the San Bernardino Police Department and the City of San Bernardino partnered to strengthen traffic and transit safety along the sbX Green Line Bus Rapid Transit corridor.

Public safety remains the top priority for all three organizations. During the past year, Omnitrans has experienced 38 non-preventable traffic collisions across the sbX Green Line corridor, often because motorists cross dedicated bus lanes. These incidents reflect the challenges that transit vehicles face while operating in complex, high-traffic urban environments and highlight the need for increased awareness, enforcement, and collaboration to improve transit safety in our community.

The new agency/law enforcement partnership is focused on being proactive to reduce incidents, support safe operations, and ensure visible public safety presence throughout the system. Collaborative efforts will include enhanced communication, coordinated field presence, and traffic enforcement along the sbX Green Line corridor from North East Street and West Highland Avenue to East Hospitality Lane and South Tippecanoe Avenue.

During last week's traffic enforcement operation, the presence of law enforcement provided an added layer of safety and reassurance for both Coach Operators and customers. Officers issued 47 traffic citations, 31 parking citations, conducted 13 vehicle impounds, and made three arrests. These enforcement efforts highlight the agencies' shared commitment to enhancing safety and maintaining orderly operations along the corridor.

"Operating safely along the sbX Green Line corridor and across Omnitrans' service area is our top priority," said Omnitrans CEO/General Manager Erin Rogers. "We look forward to continuing this impactful collaboration with the San Bernardino Police Department and City of San Bernardino to reduce traffic incidents and help ensure safe streets for all."
